**EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING COMMENTS
REGARDING REVISION OF IOWA RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT
ON ATTORNEY ADVERTISING**

On September 29, 2011, the Supreme Court Committee to Study Lawyer Advertising Rules issued a notice announcing it was seeking public comments on the adoption of the ABA Model Rules of Professional Conduct pertaining to lawyer advertising. The Committee set October 28, 2011 as the deadline for comments.

The Iowa State Bar Association has asked the committee to extend the period for public comments. The Committee consents to this request and extends the time for comments. The new deadline for submitting comments is **4:30 p.m., November 18, 2011.**

As a reminder: Comments must comply with the following requirements:

1. Comments must be delivered by email or sent by regular mail to the Supreme Court Committee to Study Lawyer Advertising Rules, Attn. Trinity Braun-Arana, 1111 East Court Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50319.
2. Comments submitted by email must be addressed to **advertising.comment@iowacourts.gov**, must state "attorney advertising rules" in the subject line of the email, and must be sent as an attachment to the email in Microsoft Word format.
3. All comments shall refer to the rule upon which comment is being made.
