
On March 25, 2004, then-Chief Judge Michael S. Walsh issued an order that the clerk of court no longer needed to keep naturalization records and indicated they could be offered first to the county recorder and if the recorder declines the records to the local historical or genealogical society. If no group or office will accept them, they shall be stored without provisions for retrieval and if there are any inquiries, the response would be they are not available.

The Woodbury County Recorder's Office did take the naturalization records and the court has now received a request authorizing their release to the Sioux City Museum.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Woodbury County Recorder's request to release all naturalization records to the Sioux City Museum is granted.
2. In the future, the Sioux City Museum may transfer, destroy or otherwise dispose of these records in whatever manner they desire, without the necessity of seeking an additional court order.
