DESIGN

The court is advised the Third Judicial District Department of Correctional Services desires to place probationers into the Woodbury County Drug Court Program as part of their intermediate criminal sanctions plan.

The court hereby appoints the Public Defender's Office to meet with, explain, and go over the terms of the Woodbury County Drug Court Agreement as well as obtain, if applicable, the probationer's consent to entry into the Woodbury County Drug Court Program. For those probationers who are being placed into the Woodbury County Drug Court Program as part of the intermediate criminal sanctions plan, the appointment of the Public Defender's Office shall be solely for the purpose of reviewing the Woodbury County Drug Court Agreement and consent form and does not constitute a general or continuing appearance of the Public Defender's Office as counsel for the probationer.

The district court administrator is directed to file this order with the Woodbury County Clerk of Court and send copies to the Woodbury County Attorney and the Chief Public Defender for Public Defender's Office in Sioux City, Iowa.
