



Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 229.19, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- A. By virtue of fact that Carol L. Neddermeyer has resigned effective June 30, 2014 a new advocate must be appointed.
- B. APPOINTMENT: Commencing July 2nd, 2014, Sandy Sweeney, PO Box 336, Manson, Iowa 50563 (cell # 712-830-3275) is appointed as mental health advocate for all patients involuntarily hospitalized by the court in matters relating to patients' hospitalization or treatment under Iowa Code Chapter 229.
- C. DUTIES: The advocate's duties shall be as provided by Iowa Code Chapter 229.
- D. COMPENSATION: The advocate's claims for compensation and mileage shall be approved by a magistrate performing mental health work in Crawford County. The rate of compensation shall be \$17.93 per hour, the same rate as Sandy Sweeney receives for serving as advocate for Ida, Sac and Calhoun counties.
