ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-39

It has been brought to the attention of the Chief Judge that William Hardin is unable to continue his appointment as Inheritance Tax Appraiser for Marion County. David Johnson has been recommended as successor Inheritance Tax Appraiser. He is a competent resident and freeholder of Marion County.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that David Johnson be and he is hereby appointed inheritance tax appraiser for Marion County, Iowa, through the appointment term of December 31, 2017, and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the aforesaid inheritance tax appraiser shall take an oath to faithfully and impartially perform the duties of the office, but shall not be required to give bond.
