ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2015-42

**WHEREAS** Iowa Code §§602.1211(1) and 602.6105(1) and Iowa Court Rules 22.5 and 22.8(1) provide the Chief Judge shall designate the places of holding court in the district:

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

Criminal proceedings involving inmates in the custody of the county sheriff not requiring a jury may be held in a secure conference room or courtroom in the Taylor County Law Enforcement Center, 601 Justice Street, Bedford, IA, 50832. Such jail court facility shall be maintained in a neutral setting with the trappings of the court, including a desk for the judicial officer, flags and a copy of the Iowa Code. Such jail court facility shall be maintained separately from law enforcement offices or detention facilities in the jail. All jail court proceedings shall be public either by allowing the public to attend in the conference room or courtroom or by allowing the public to observe via audiovisual closed circuit television.
