6. Physician's Report of Examination Pursuant to Iowa Code section 229.10(2).
7. Notice of Medication Pursuant to Iowa Code section 229.12(1).
8. Chief Medical Officer's Report of Psychiatric Evaluation Pursuant to Iowa Code section 229.14.
9. Chief Medical Officer's Periodic Report Pursuant to Iowa Code section 229.15(1).
10. Chief Medical Officer's Periodic Report Pursuant to Iowa Code section 229.15(2).
11. Periodic Report Pursuant to Iowa Code section 229.15(3).

The original document shall be promptly filed with the clerk of court. Any document received and filed as authorized by this order is admissible as a "duplicate" under Iowa Rule of Evidence 5.1003.

This authorization is in addition to the authorization for facsimile transmissions for filing and issuing orders and warrants granted by this court's supervisory order of December 30, 1994.
