There are immense ramifications to any data breach. Not only is there a significant disruption to business operations, there are fines, reputational damage, and other costs. Today, the average cyber-attack costs over \$1 million. It is imperative that judicial branch personnel understand the need and means to protect sensitive information.

As good public stewards, judicial officers and judicial branch employees must do everything reasonably possible to safeguard sensitive information. There are best practices for online information security that the judicial branch will follow.

All judicial officers and judicial branch employees are required to complete the online information security awareness training used by the State of Iowa. The "Securing the Human" security awareness training takes approximately one hour. The training will begin September 12, 2019, and must be completed by close of business on October 12, 2019.

For judicial officers, staff attorneys, and law clerks, state court administration has gained approval for one hour of CLE credit for the training (Activity #330271).
