Judge Service Time)**

Work and vacation schedules of active and senior judges were affected by the pandemic during most of 2020 and continue to be affected. However, the demand for judicial officer time is now increasing as in-person services and proceedings are resuming. Acknowledging these challenges during the past 15 months, the court suspends for one year the limit in Iowa Court Rule 22.14(1) on vacation time carryover. The limit on carryover vacation days will not apply from 2020 through 2021 but will resume in 2022. The court further orders that senior judges, with approval of the chief judge of the district or court to whom they have been assigned, may complete required 2020 and 2021 senior judge service time in 2022. This does not reduce the senior judge’s service time that would be otherwise required in 2022.
