**In the Matter of Remote Testimony
in Judicial Proceedings**

Order

In an effort to provide clarification and uniformity in Iowa courts, the supreme court issues this order regarding remote testimony in judicial proceedings. This order replaces all previous orders issued regarding remote testimony, including those contained in the amended December 6, 2021 order. This order is effective immediately and remains in effect until further order.

Remote Testimony: With the availability of appropriate technology, remote testimony during any court proceeding is allowed only with the consent of all parties and in the court's discretion unless otherwise provided by law.
