General case description: The State seeks further review of the court of appeals decision reversing and remanding Michael James Jones's convictions following a jury trial for possession of methamphetamine and marijuana. The court agreed with Jones's argument that there was insufficient evidence to support the convictions on the basis Jones's mere proximity to the drugs alone cannot support a finding of constructive possession.
