We have been informed the Jackson County Courthouse in Maquoketa, Iowa, Seventh Judicial District, will be closed from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, August 5, 2022. The purpose for this closing is mandatory security training will be conducted for all county employees within the Jackson County Courthouse.
