

## **NOTICE OF PART-TIME JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE POSITION**

The Ida County Judicial Magistrate Appointing Commission will meet in the magistrate courtroom at the Ida County Courthouse in Ida Grove, Ida County, Iowa, on December 10, 2018, at 2:30 p.m. for the purpose of appointing one part-time Magistrate to serve in Ida County for an unexpired term ending July 31, 2021.

All applicants must be a resident of Ida County or a resident of a county contiguous to Ida County during the term of office. Ida County Magistrates serve within the judicial district of 3B, as directed by the Chief Judge, and may be assigned by the Chief Judge to hold court outside of Ida County for the orderly administration of justice. All applicants must be under the age of 72 years at the time of appointment. All applicants must also be an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Iowa. Additional information, duties, and qualifications can be obtained with the application.

Applications shall be submitted in accordance with instructions given no later than 4:00 p.m. on November 30, 2018. Applicants and Commission Members may but are not required to conduct individual interviews before December 10, 2018. Applicants are otherwise requested to appear for an interview before the entire Commission on December 10, 2018, at a scheduled time to be determined later. The meeting is open to all persons.
