IN RE: REPORTING OF NON-TESTIMONIAL HEARINGS ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2024-2 (MODIFYING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2023-39)

On November 30, 2023, Administrative Order 2023-39 was entered to address the issue of requests for records by a court reporter in non-testimonial hearings. Because of pragmatic and logistical issues that have been identified since the entry of that order, some modifications are now necessary. Accordingly, Paragraph 2 of Administrative Order 2023-39 is modified by deleting the first and third sentences and modifying the language in the second sentence, so that the paragraph will now read as follows:

Once the hearing has been set, a later request may be made, up to and including the day of the hearing, but will only be granted upon a finding of good cause.

The remainder of Administrative Order 2023-39 shall remain in full force and effect. This modification is effective immediately.
