MAGISTRATE ASSIGNMENTSADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2024-7
(MODIFYING ORDER 2023-27)

Traditionally, the schedule for magistrates in Polk County has required to be available two days each week to cover dockets as assigned. That schedule has not always resulted in the efficient allocation of judicial resources; accordingly, it will be changed effective to coordinate with the next docket rotation. As of August 5, 2024, the Polk County magistrates will be scheduled on a block basis, with each magistrate working for a full week with one or two weeks off before their next assigned docket. Attached to this order is a revised Exhibit "A" which sets out the schedule and assignments going forward as of the effective date of this change. In all other respects, Administrative Order 2023-27 shall continue to control.
