ORDER

The observance of various legal holidays requires the rescheduling of district court days in the outer counties of the district.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that court days normally held on Monday or Tuesday for Allamakee, Buchanan, Chickasaw, Clayton, Delaware, Fayette, Grundy, Howard and Winneshiek will move to Wednesday of the week the holidays are observed.


Due to the moving of these court days, there will be **NO** Fayette Supplemental Court on Wednesday of these holiday weeks.
