

How to get married at the courthouse

You will need:

- Valid marriage license (3-day waiting period has passed)
- You, your spouse-to-be, and two witnesses, all four of you over the age of 18 WITH valid forms of identification.

Your party needs to be checked in on the lower level of the courthouse by 1:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding state holidays. This is the only time offered. As this time is order hour for traffic court, official court business goes first. The wait time depends on how much official court business there is. As long as you are here by 1:00, we will do our best to get you taken care of.

This process is very informal. There is no ceremony, no vows, and no ring exchange. It consists of just signing papers.

There is no fee.
