Special Message Regarding the Ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic

The court acknowledges this is a very trying time in our nation's history and many potential jurors have had their lives disrupted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Jury trials are among the core foundations of our freedom and democracy, and the Court hopes you can make the necessary sacrifice to assist by serving as a potential juror.

If you do not feel you can serve as a potential juror for any of the reasons listed below, the Court encourages you to request a postponement or contact the Jury Manager at **111-222-1234**.

- You are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (fever greater than 100 degrees, new loss of taste or smell, unusual shortness of breath, fatigue) and:
 - o You have tested positive for COVID-19 **or**
 - o You believe you will test positive for COVID-19
- You are caring for someone who tested positive for COVID-19
- You are a member of a high-risk population
- You are caring for or living with someone who is high-risk
- You are afraid to be in a large group for an extended period even if physically distanced six feet from others and everyone is wearing a face covering
- You are a medical professional currently treating COVID-19 patients

Postponement can be used for hardship, inconvenience, public necessity, temporary physical or mental illness or infirmity, active educational pursuit, or scheduled vacation. If your scheduled reporting date is at least ten days in the future, you may request a postponement through eJuror. Requests made fewer than ten days prior to your reporting date, or secondary requests for postponement, must be made through the Court; such requests will only be granted for good cause and may require supporting documentation.

If you have internet access and believe you will be eligible to serve, the Court highly recommends that you respond online at jury.iowacourts.gov and view the Orientation Video, which is on the final landing page after completing your questionnaire.

If you believe you are eligible to serve but do not have internet access, please fill out the front of this form and return it to the Jury Manager.

When responding to your questionnaire, whether by paper or through the online questionnaire, please provide an email address and/or cell phone number *and* carrier information so that the Jury Manager can send updates and notifications regarding your jury service.
