The court had previously designated the weeks of July 20, 2020 and August 10, 2020 as jury weeks, in anticipation of resuming criminal jury trials by then. That timeframe has since been modified by the supreme court's supervisory order dated May 22, 2020; jury trials are now not scheduled to resume until September 14, 2020. In light of this development, the weeks of July 20, 2020 and August 10, 2020 shall return to being non-jury weeks. In addition, the weeks of October 12, 2020 and December 7, 2020 shall be converted from non-jury weeks to jury weeks to provide for maximum time to schedule the anticipated need for criminal jury trials.
