**VOGEL, J.**

The father of a child born in September 2005 appeals the district court's denial of his motion for visitation while he is imprisoned on drug charges. After our de novo review of the record on appeal, we adopt the district court's detailed fact findings and application of the law. Iowa R. App. P. 6.4. We conclude the best interests of the child weigh in favor of denying the father's motion for visitation at this time. Iowa R. App. P. 6.14(6)(o). Therefore, we affirm pursuant to Iowa Court Rule 21.29(1)(a), (d), and (e).
